<u>The Screwtape Letters.</u> Screwtape instructs Wormwood to make a list of all the young women in the Patient's neighborhood that would prove to be bad marriage matches for the Patient.

<u>The Great Divorce</u> poses the question, will the people in Hell remain in Hell for all eternity, or one day, will God free them and bring them to Heaven?


